	3	To engage in the learning process by noting the key metaphysical presuppositions and positions of each of the religions studied
	4	To develop an awareness of the influence that each of the religions studied has had on the world as we know it.
	5	To demonstrate the ability to use basic research tools available in the field of religion and philosophy, and draw reasonable conclusions on the basis of careful study.
	6	To demonstrate competence in the use of religious terms, such as ultimate reality, myth, symbol, ritual.
	7	To respond critically through the written medium and orally in class the key epistemological positions of each of the religions studied.
	8	To distinguish exoteric or external expressions of religion (doctrine and ritual, e.g.) from esoteric expressions of religion (secret, inner knowing possessed by a few).
