18	Objective of the Course:	<p>In this course, acquiring knowledge of students about Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP) and European Security and Defence Policy (ESDP) of European Union (EU) via contributing other courses which was taken or will be taken courses about EU during post-graduate education by students spesificly.
