In this process, it is aimed that the students first examine the relevant basic sources, comprehend the physical and social contexts of the exhibitions cognitively and emotionally, and make sense of the events that affect the Biennials and Fairs in today's art, such as Dokümenta and Manifesta, by associating them with the changing nature of art.
