2	<p>2.General Information on Rights and Freedoms</p> <p>The meaning of fundamental rights and liberty, rights and human rights with the concept of an ordinary (difference, in terms of the same or a similar) relationships, relationship between security and liberty, evaluation and discussion of security regulation constitutions necessary or not.</p>	
3	<p>3.Week: According to the 1982 Constitution of Rights and Freedoms</p> <p>In 1982 Constitution, fundamental rights and freedoms, their attributes and the provisions regarding the restriction of the rights and freedoms, democratic state in terms of the provisions of the Constitution of 1982 evaluation of the issue of security.</p>	
4	<p>4.Week: The Law Enforcement Activities Related the Separations Varieties</p> <p>Public law concepts of duty and authority, the duties and powers of law enforcement, Procedures of law enforcement (permission, notification, and procedures of freedom), law enforcement measures, lighting concepts in terms of penalties and law enforcement to fight crime and crime: definition of preventive law enforcement and criminal law enforcement, evaluation.</p>
